In 1833 a very extensive revival prevailed all through this section. John C. Ayers, one of the evangelistic preachers of this section was a power for good. Preaching was established in Unionville with Peter Burroughs preaching the first sermon in the basement of this church, which the members built mostly with their own hands father said. Charles, Emily and Eliza Cumings were members of this class of 1833 at Unionville. The North Madison Society was organized in 1833 and the log Chapel built in 1834. There was quite a revival in the log chapel in 1837. A class

Sabbath School in the King School house for some time longer. A class

was easily formed at Madison Gore, South of Centerville (Madison Village).

The frame church at North Madison was began in about 1849, but not completed until 1851. This building was repaired in 1908 during the pastorate of J.G. Exline. A memorial window was then placed in the front of the Chapel by the children of Charles Cumings. This was so placed as a memorial by his entire family.

There was an early class formed in Centerville, but was soon united with the Unionville church. It was reorganized some time later. The church edifice was built and the parsonage on Union Street bought and paid for curing the pastorate of E.R. Knapp in 1864 and 65.

The parsonage on the square was built during the pastorate of W.T.S. Culp.
